What Areas does Bless1.org service?

Bless1.org serves Houston and Peach Counties, Georgia (Ho-Pe).

How does Bless1.org food donations work?

Bless1.org collects and distributes food to feed the needy by sponsoring food drives, assisting community food organizations and programs. Food donations are always a critical need.

Bless1.org partners with schools, community groups, faith communities and civic organizations, in addition to generous caring hearted individuals in our community to collect for hungry families in Houston and Peach Counties, Georgia.

How can someone utilize Bless1.org clothing program?

Clients that need clothing and other personal effects are given vouchers to shop at local area Goodwill and Thrift stores. These resale stores and donation centers provides quality recycled clothing, furniture and miscellaneous articles at minimal cost. Bless1.org also donates directly to and collaborates with other community organizations that provides clothing and personal effects.

How does Bless1.org assist the homeless or someone at risk of becoming homeless?

Bless1.org help the homeless find local homeless shelters, resources, temporary, and affordable housing assistance and provide them with homeless care kits.

Will Bless1.org help me pay some of my bills?

Bless1.org provides emergency financial assistance to help individuals and families with utilities, rent, mortgage, medical expenses, car expenses and other essential needs. Bless1.org's goal is to keep families from becoming homeless. We will help families to find matching funds from other community resources and agencies in order to cover one-time financial crises if Bless1.org is unable to help with the entire bill.

Families are encouraged to help match a portion of the funds needed. Bless1.org works closely with other local Agencies in order to maximize available resources and avoid duplication.

How will Bless1.org help me get back on the right track?

Bless1.org works one-on-one with clients that require individual training and counseling assistance. Our sincere and discreet staff members understand that this is a hard time for our clients and we work to empower people with basic life skills by addressing such topics as budget management, basic computer skills, locating housing, how to retain housing, accessing transportation, problem solving, resolving medical issues, resume writing, and finding and keeping employment.

How can I utilize Bless1.org's professional services?

Bless1.org partners with local attorneys to provide pro bono legal services to clients. An attorney or paralegal is available once a month to meet with clients at their convenience. Clients are able to get assistance on a wide range of civil matters, including employment, immigration, and housing; family matters such as child custody and support, divorce, public benefits and consumer matters.

Can Bless1.org help me get to a job interview or doctor appointment?

Bless1.org provide limited transportation to clients for job or educational related services, medical appointments, social services appointments, emergency situations, etc., on a case by case basis. Also engage in other activities, information and referral to additional related resources.
